BYELAWS

Made by the Breckland District Council
for the regulation and management of:--

Barnham Cross Common, Thetford

Broadwater Common, Thetford

Melford Common, Thetford

School Plain, Thetford

Two Mile Bottom Common, Thetford

and notes on certain relevant statutes.

Trapping

5. No person shall without lawful excuse or authority on the Commons kill, molest or wilfully disturb any animal, or bird or engage in hunting or shooting or the setting of traps or the laying of snares.

Vehicles and Structures

6. No person shall without lawful authority of the Council

- (a) draw or drive upon the Commons any carriage, cart, caravan, truck, motor vehicle, motor cycle or any other vehicle
- (b) erect or permit to remain on the Commons any building, shed, tent, fence, post or other structure whether used in connection with the playing of games or not.

PROVIDED that this Byelaw shall not be deemed to apply to any offence which is punishable under Section 193 of the Law of Property Act 1925.

Aeroplanes

7. No person shall without lawful authority land on or depart from the Commons in an aeroplane or other flying machine except in the case of accident or other sufficient cause.

Unauthorised Fairs etc.

8. No person shall except in the case of a fair lawfully held place on the Commons any show, exhibition, swing, roundabout or other like thing.

Firearms and Missiles

9. No person shall while he is on the Commons:

- (a) have in his possession any firearm unless it is so covered with a securely fastened gun cover that it cannot be fired. In this Byelaw the expression "firearm" means any lethal barrelled weapon of any description from which any shot, bullet or other missile can be discharged
- (b) negligently throw or discharge any missile to the danger of any person.

PENALTIES

Fines for Offences

16. Every person who shall offend against any of these foregoing Byelaws shall be liable on summary conviction to a fine not exceeding £50 and in case of a continuing offence falling within the provisions of Byelaws 6, 8 or 11 a further fine not exceeding £5 for each day of such continuance.

Removal of Offending Items

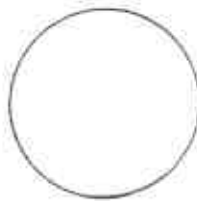
17. Any officer of the Council may after due warning remove from the Commons any vehicle or animal drawn, driven or placed or any structure erected or placed thereon in contravention of these Byelaws or remove or exclude from the Commons any person who within his view infringes any of these Byelaws or any provision of the Vagrancy Act 1824.

Freehold Rights

18. Nothing in these Byelaws shall prejudice or affect any right of the person entitled as lord of the manor or otherwise to the soil of the Commons or of any person claiming under him which is lawfully exercisable in, over, under or on the soil or surface of the Commons in connection with game or with mines, minerals or other substrata or otherwise or prejudice or affect any right of the commoners in or over the Commons or the lawful use of any highway or thoroughfare on the Commons or affect any power or obligation to repair any such highway or thoroughfare.

Repeal of Previous Byelaws

19. The Byelaws relating to Barnham Cross Common, Thetford, made by the Council of the Borough of Thetford acting as the Urban District Council on 25th July 1923 and allowed by the Minister of Health on 9th August 1923 are hereby repealed.

The following matters are also contrary to the law and subject to prosecution.

Fires

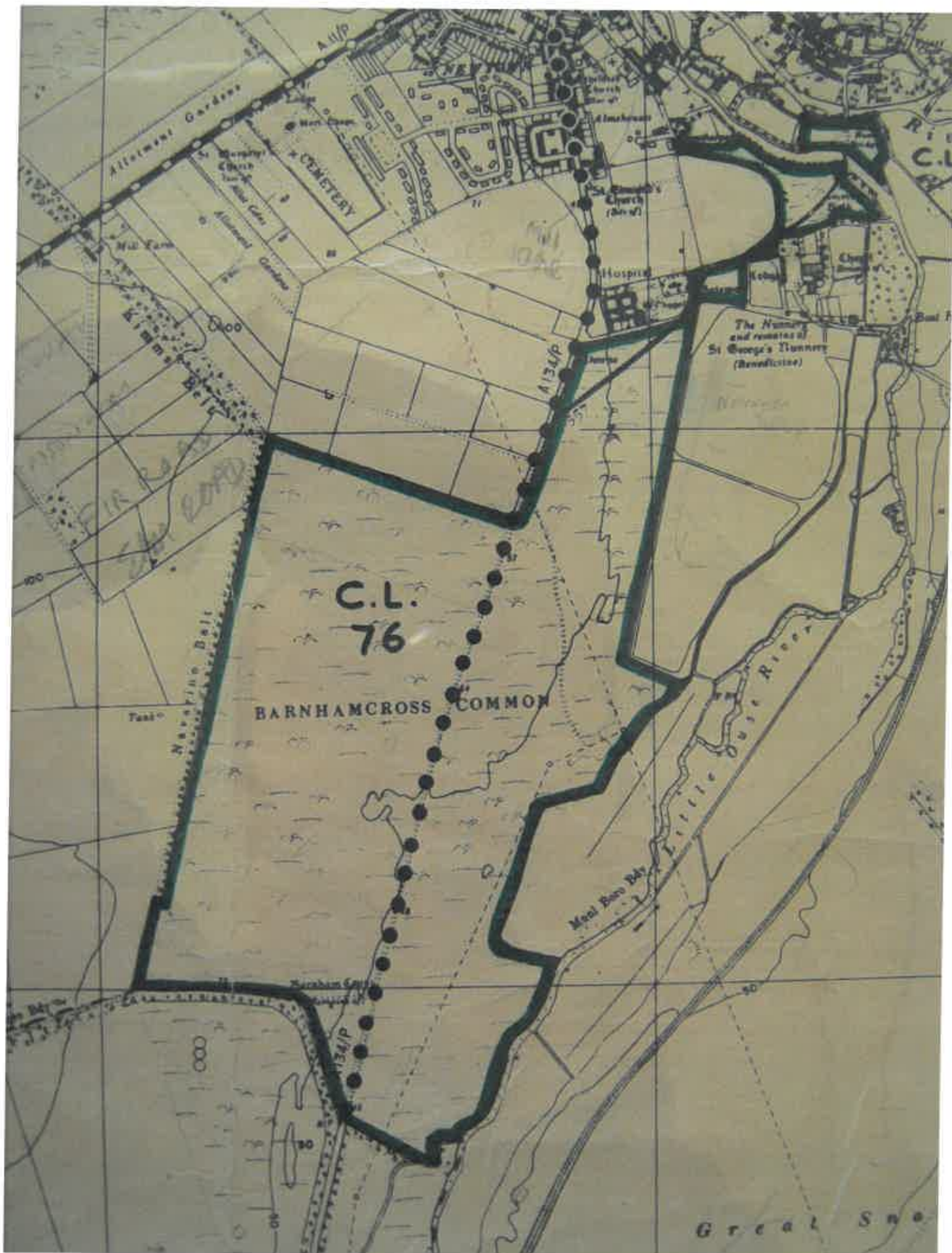
The lighting of fires on common land is an offence under the Law of Property Act, 1925 and the Criminal Damage Act, 1971 deals with any damage caused by fire.

Fireworks

The Explosives Act, 1875 makes it an offence to throw, cast or fire any fireworks in or into a public place and the Explosive Substances Act, 1883 makes it an offence to unlawfully cause an explosion which may endanger life or cause serious injury to property.

Litter

It is an offence to throw down, drop or deposit in, into or from any place in the open air to which the public are entitled or permitted to have access without payment anything whatsoever in such circumstances as to cause, contribute to or tend to or lead to the defacement by litter of that place.

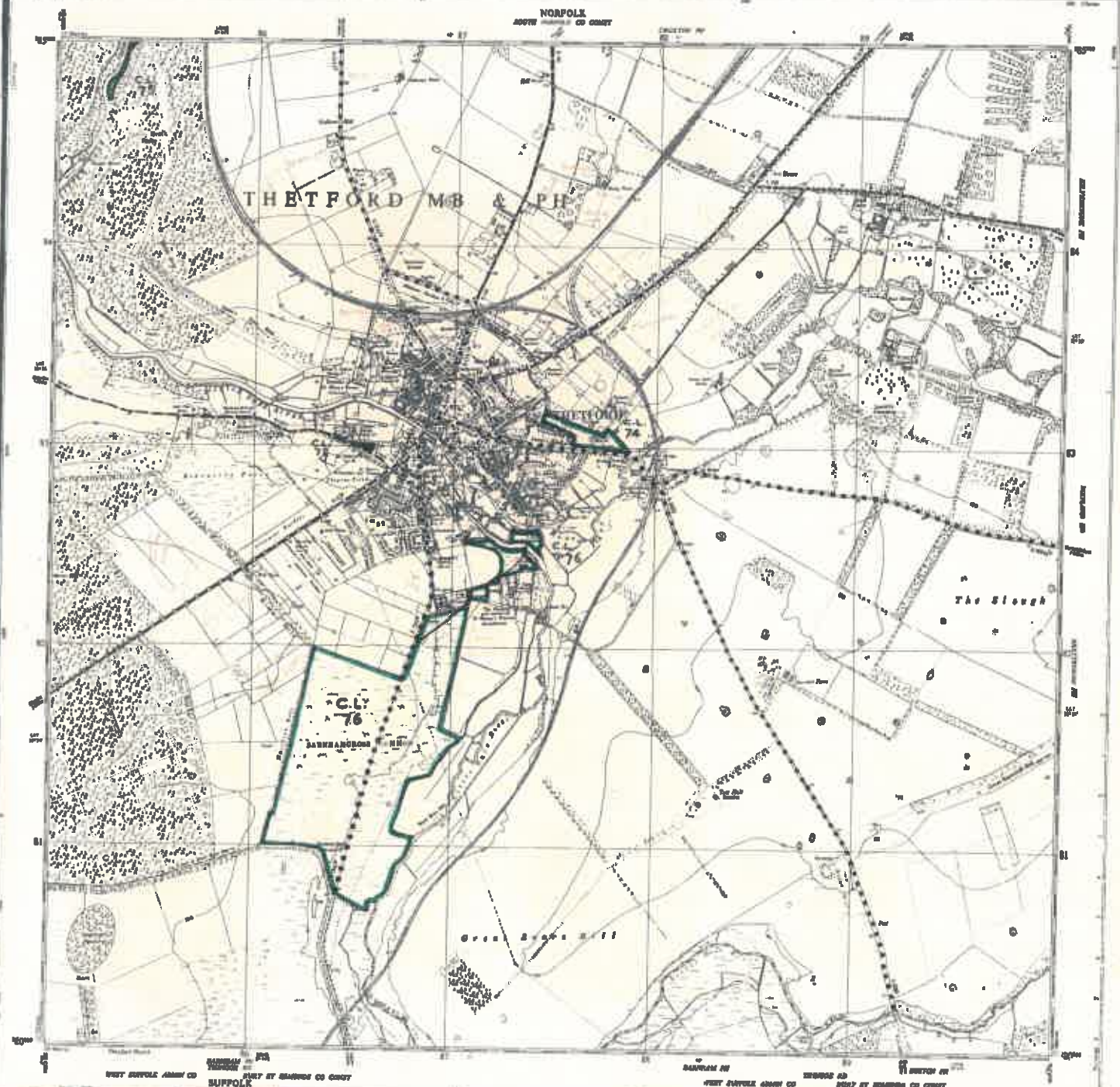
